REPORT OF THE INDEPENDENT AUDITORS TO THE MEMBERS OF PFA SCOTLAND

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2015

We have audited the financial statements on pages 5 to 10 which comprise the income and Expenditure account and Balance Sheet and related notes.

This report is made solely to the Association's members, as a body in accordance with Section 36 of the Trade Union & Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992. Our audit work has been undertaken so that we might state to the Association's members those matters we are required to state to them in an auditor's report and for no other purpose. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we do not accept or assume responsibility to anyone other than the Association and the Association's members as a body, for our audit work, or for the opinions we have formed.

Respective responsibilities of Management Committee and Auditors

The board members' responsibilities for preparing the Annual Report and Financial Statements in accordance with applicable law and United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice) are set out in the Statement of their Responsibilities. Our responsibility is to audit the financial statements in accordance with the relevant legal and regulatory requirements and international Standards on Auditing (UK and Ireland). We report to you if in our opinion the report is not consistent with the financial statements, if the Association has not kept proper accounting accounting records, or maintained a satisfactory system of control over its transactions in accordance with Section 28 of the Trade Union and Labour Relations (Consolidation) Act 1992, if the accounts do not agree with the accounting records or if we have not received all the information and explanations we require for our audit. We read other information contained in the Annual report, and consider whether it is consistent with the audited financial statements.
