Penalties – If your MQ/13 form is late or incomplete you will be liable to pay a penalty equal to the levy due on 0.01% of your volume deliveries for each calendar day's delay. The minimum penalty for any late return is €100 up to a maximum of €100,000. Approximately £75 and £75,000 respectively.

If it is found that you have made an incorrect declaration, you will be liable to pay a penalty equal to the levy due on 0.5% of the volume of milk involved. The minimum penalty applicable will be £60 up to a maximum of £60,000.

If the UK reaches a levy position and we find that you have not declared all your deliveries, you will be liable to pay levy on the butterfat adjusted volume you have under declared.
