RA 2130 regulates safety equipment, survival drills and training and a change to Annex A updates and streamlines wet winch periodicity. Additionally, a change to paragraph 6 reduces the number of parachute landings that require aircrew to wear full Aircrew Equipment Assemblies.

RA 2135 regulates aircrew medical requirements, and a change to paragraph 57 recognizes the impact of chemical warfare training agent exposure on supernumerary crew.

RA 2305 regulates the supervision of flying, and this change updates the references for Air Exercise Planning and the emphasis for supervisors of flying units to also provide mission planning facilities, in addition to access to prepare flight plans.

RA 2309 regulates flight procedures, and a change to paragraph 18 clarifies the rules for UK military aircraft flying in the company of civil aircraft.

In addition, alongside a number of purely grammatical changes, the rationale for these RAs has been reviewed, and whilst the wording used has changed, the MAA intent remains unaltered.
