

NOTICE OF ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53

Derbyshire County Council
(Footpath between Clowne Road and Church Road - Bolsover) Modification
Order 2014

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is 31 May 2016.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by adding to them a Public Footpath in Bolsover from point A (Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (GR) SK 4719 7370) proceeding in a south south easterly direction to point B (GR SK 4733 7336). Then proceeding in a generally south easterly then easterly direction to point C (GR SK 4738 7334). Then in a north north westerly then easterly then south easterly then south westerly then southerly direction through woodland to point D (GR SK 4740 7321) and finally in an east south easterly direction to point E (GR SK 4754 7315), a total distance of 780 metres or thereabouts.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 14 June 2016]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the

Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 26 July 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 6 September 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

THE DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (FOOTPATH BETWEEN CLOWNE ROAD AND CHURCH ROAD - BOLSOVER) MODIFICATION ORDER 2014

This order is made by Derbyshire County Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement in respect of Bolsover require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely, the discovery by that authority of evidence which when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them shows that the right of way referred to in this order which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates.

The authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Derbyshire County Council hereby orders that:

1. For the purpose of this order the relevant date is 1 January 2014.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Derbyshire for Bolsover shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map to the order.
3. This order shall take effect on the date when it is confirmed and may be cited as the Derbyshire County Council (Footpath between Clowne Road and Church Road - Bolsover) Modification Order 2014.

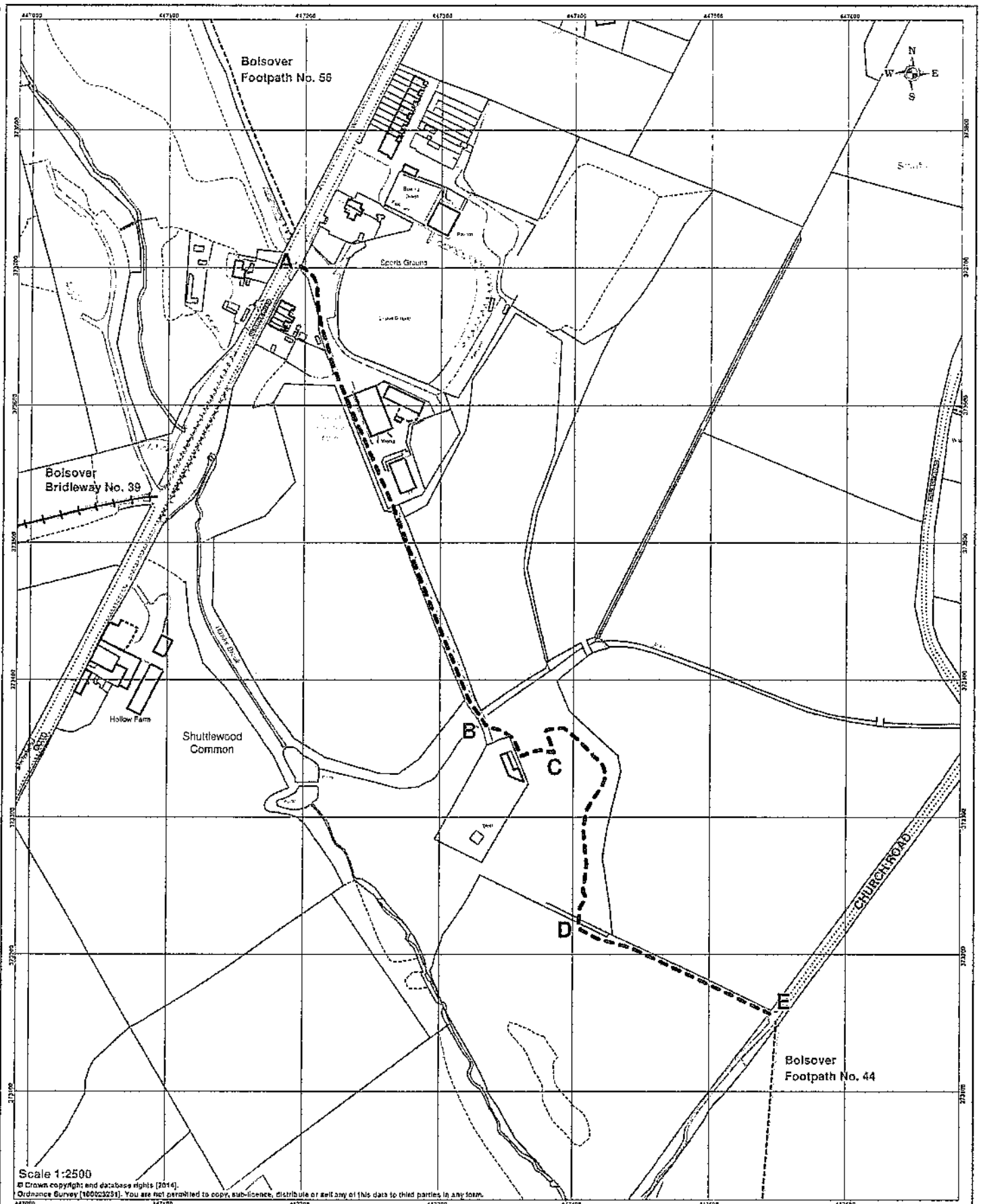
