Consideration of the Orders will take the form of a hearing.

The Hearing will be held at Great Gonerby Social Club, 8 High Street, Great Gonerby, Grantham, Lincs, NG31 8JP on Tuesday 29 November 2016 at 10.00am.

The effect of the Orders, if confirmed without modifications, will be to:-

1) [the 1985 Order] - modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding thereto in the Parishes of Belton and Manthorpe and Great Gonerby a bridleway, covering the full width of a track and adjacent verges, to be a minimum of 4.5 metres in width commencing at Belton Lane, Great Gonerby between the properties known as No's 45 and 47 and following a track running generally north eastwards along the north west boundary of OS Fields No's 2300, 5252 and 6712, then south eastwards through a property known as Gonerby Grange, crossing a bridge over a railway line, along the southern boundary of OS Fields No's 2464 and 5358 to the A607, Belton.

2) [the 1991 Order] - modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding thereto a public footpath in the Parishes of Belton and Manthorpe and Great Gonerby to be approximately 3 metres in width, running along a track from a point on Belton Lane, Great Gonerby between the properties known as numbers 45 and 47, generally north-north-eastwards across field OS no 1487 and along the northern boundaries of fields OS no's 2300, 5252 and 6712 for a distance of approximately 1190 metres, then running north-eastwards across field OS no's 5700 and 6700 for a distance of approximately 380 metres and generally east-south-eastwards along the track across field OS no 6820, through the property known as Gonerby Grange, crossing a bridge over a railway line and continuing along the southern boundary of field OS Fields no 5400 and north of field OS no's 0076, 0067, 0966, 1471, 2464 and 5358 for a distance of approximately 2390 metres to meet the public highway A607, west of Belton village for a total distance of approximately 3580 metres.

As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Orders.

Within 12 weeks of the start date [by 06 September 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Hearing must ensure their statement of case¹ is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Orders (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Orders (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.


