

NOTICE OF ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53

Northamptonshire County Council
(Public Footpath NG9 - Parish of Lilford-cum-Wigsthorpe Definitive Map
Modification Order 2014

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Orders has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is 12 July 2016 .

Consideration of the Order will take the form of a public local inquiry.

The Inquiry will be held at **Northamptonshire County Council's Sessions House, The Courtroom, County Hall, George Row, Northampton NN1 1DF** on **Tuesday 13 December 2016** at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to the particulars of Public Footpath NG9 described in the Schedule below, following the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area which the map relates, being a right of way to which this part applies. Also that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description as described in the Schedule below.

Description of footpath to be added

Public Footpath NG9 in the Parish of Lilford-Cum-Wigsthorpe commencing at Point A on the Order Map at National Grid Reference ("NGR") TL02977 83438 and proceeding in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 411 metres to point B on the Order Map at NGR TL03250 83735. The route then continues in a north-easterly direction along a stone track for a distance of 436 metres to NGR TL03499 84084. The route then continues

in a north-easterly direction for a further 554 metres to meet public footpath NG1 at Point C on the Order Map at NGR TL03783 84560.

The route is as shown on the Order map by a broken black line between point "A" "B" and "C". The footpath to be added has a width of 1.8 metres.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and proofs of evidence

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 6 September 2016]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's

offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation and the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 18 October 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their statement of case¹ is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

4 weeks before the date of the inquiry [by 15 November 2016]

The Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their proof of evidence (together with any summary) is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of:

- i) the Authority's proof of evidence to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and anyone who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence);
- ii) the applicant's proof of evidence to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence); and
- iii) all other proofs of evidence to the Authority, the applicant, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence).

¹ If you wish to make a legal submission, this should be submitted at the same time as your statement of case. Otherwise legal submissions will have to be submitted in writing on the day of the inquiry.

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case and proofs of evidence are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.

THIS ORDER IS MADE BY Northamptonshire County Council under Section 53(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to Northamptonshire County Council that the Northamptonshire Definitive Map and Statement ("the Definitive Map and Statement") requires modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c) of the Act, namely, the discovery by Northamptonshire County Council of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available) shows that a right of way which is not shown on the Definitive Map and Statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the Definitive Map and Statement relates, being a right of way to which this part of the Act applies.

Northamptonshire County Council has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which this Order relates. Northamptonshire County Council hereby order that: -

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 3rd July 2014.
2. The Northamptonshire Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in Part 1 and Part 2 of the Schedule and as shown on the map attached to this Order.
3. This Order shall have effect 7 days from the date of confirmation.
4. Where immediately before the date on which this Order is made there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
5. This Order may be cited as "The Northamptonshire County Council (Public Footpath NG9 - Parish of Lilford-Cum-Wigsthorpe) Definitive Map Modification Order 2014"


