### FORM OF PUBLIC NOTICE

In accordance with the requirements of the Offshore Combustion Installations (Pollution Prevention and Control) Regulations 2013, Nexen Petroleum UK Limited has applied to the Secretary of State for Energy and Climate Change (DECC) for a permit to operate combustion installations at the Golden Eagle Facilities in Block 20/01.
