

Important information for
new university entrants
in England

MENINGITIS AND SEPTICAEMIA CAN KILL VERY QUICKLY

- Cases caused by meningococcal W (MenW) bacteria are increasing in the UK
- Teenagers and young adults have a higher risk of meningococcal W disease
- The MenACWY vaccine protects against 4 meningococcal groups (A, C, W and Y)

If you are starting university,
go to your GP to get the
vaccination before you go.
If you miss out, you can still
register with a GP at uni and
get the vaccination there.

All new university entrants up
to 25 years old are eligible for
the MenACWY vaccine
