

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY PUBLIC PATH ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 3(6) of Schedule 14 to the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the London Borough of Havering (Public Footpath 198) Stopping Up and Diversion Order 2015 proposes to modify the order by providing for the following modifications:

- In part 2 of the Schedule to the Order, add, after 'Commencing at' 'the existing footpath 198 at', and add, after 'approximately 87 meters to' 'a junction with St Mary's Lane at'
- Also in part 2 of the Schedule, delete '1.8 meters' and add '2 metres or the width of the tarmac surface, whichever is greater, to a maximum of 2.95 metres.'

A copy of the order as submitted and a copy of the order showing the proposed modification together with the Inspector's Order decision dated 25 July 2016 have been deposited at the Public Advice and Service Centre, Liberty Shopping Centre, Romford RM1 3RL between the hours of 8.30am to 5.30pm (Monday to Friday) and may be inspected free of charge during normal working hours.
