

Information sheet – children aged 5-6

What is this leaflet about?

There is a new vaccine for children. It goes up their nose so it just tickles a little bit and we are seeing how it works.

You don't have to help us and you can say 'NO'.

What will happen if I do help?

Your nurse will ask you and your Mummy or Daddy how you are feeling.

Your nurse will give you the vaccine up your nose. It doesn't hurt, but it might tickle a little bit or make you sneeze.



We will do two blood tests and your nurse will give you some special cream so it shouldn't hurt.

Your nurse or mummy will rub a soft sponge on a stick over your

teeth, just like brushing your teeth. It feels a bit funny but it doesn't hurt.

If you get a cold or cough Mummy will rub a cotton bud inside of your nose. Here is a picture of how they will do it.

Mummy will write down how you have been feeling for a week after the medicine.
