### Byway Open to All Traffic No 42 (Parish of Ingram)

Adding thereto a byway open to all traffic, from a point marked U, on the C54 road, 160 metres west of Brandon Farm, in a general northerly direction along the U1090 road for a distance of 1605 metres, to a point marked T, on alleged Byway Open to All Traffic No 16 in the Parish of Roddam, 770 metres south-east of Roddam Farmhouse.

#### Byway Open to All Traffic No 16 (Parish of Roddam)

Adding thereto a byway open to all traffic, from a point marked T, on alleged Byway Open to All Traffic No 42 in the Parish of Ingram, 770 metres south-east of Roddam Farmhouse, in a general north-westerly direction along the U1090 road for a distance of 725 metres, to a point marked S, on the U1089 road, 540 metres north-east of Roddam Farmhouse.

#### Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

#### Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 28 September 2016]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

#### Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 9 November 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

#### Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 21 December 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties <u>everyone should keep to the timetable</u> to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

# Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland

## **The Northumberland County Council**

**Definitive Map Modification Order (No 16) 2015** 

Byways Open to All Traffic Nos 42 & 16 (Parishes of Ingram & Roddam)

This Order is made by Northumberland County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i) and (iii), namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic; and that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The authority has consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Northumberland County Council hereby order that:

- 1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 September 2015.
- The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland shall be modified as described in the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Northumberland County Council Definitive Map Modification Order (No 16) 2015.

Thereafter as a 9 metre wide byway, continuing in a northerly direction for a distance of 240 metres. Thereafter as an 8 to 9 metre wide byway in a northerly direction for a further 360 metres. Thereafter as a 6.5 to 8 metre wide byway in a northerly direction for a further 210 metres, then north-westerly direction for a distance of 60 metres. Thereafter as a 5 metre wide byway, continuing in a north-westerly direction for a further 315 metres, then northerly direction for a distance of 40 metres to join Byway Open to All Traffic No 16 in the Parish of Roddam, 770 metres south-east of Roddam



north-east of Roddam Farmhouse.


