Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Orders have been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Orders.

The start date for the above Orders is **12 September 2016**.

Consideration of the Orders will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the first Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert the following public footpaths:

Malmesbury St Paul Without 13 running from OS GR ST 9460-8690 in a south-easterly direction for approximately 278 metres to OS GR ST 9482-8672 to a line running from OS GR ST 9460-8690 in a south-easterly direction along the field boundary for approximately 293 metres to OS GR ST 9482-8672.

Malmesbury St Paul Without 16 running from OS GR ST 9487-8747 in a southerly direction for approximately 713 metres to OS GR ST 9493-8677 to a line running from OS GR ST 9487-8747 in a south-westerly direction for approximately 649 metres to OS Grid Reference ST 9459-8691.

Malmesbury St Paul Without 17 running from OS GR ST 9455-8666 in a westerly direction for approximately 76 metres to the parish boundary at OS GR ST 9447-8666 to a line running from OS GR ST 9455-8666 in a westerly direction for approximately 47 metres to the parish boundary at OS GR ST 9449-8664.

Lea and Cleverton 1A running from OS GR ST 9446-8662 in a northerly direction for approximately 35 metres to parish boundary at OS GR ST

9447-8666 to a line running from OS GR ST 9446-8662 in a northeasterly direction for approximately 37 metres to the parish boundary at OS GR ST 9449-8664.

The effect of the second Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to extinguish the public footpath running from Southfield Farm, at OS GR ST 9496-8677, in a south-westerly direction for approximately 77 metres, then south-easterly for approximately 118m to OS GR ST 9492-8663. If confirmed the order will also have the effect of modifying the Malmesbury Rural District Council area definitive map and statement dated 1952 accordingly.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 7 November 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order. Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 19 December 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Orders must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

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

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PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 WILTSHIRE COUNCIL THE WILTSHIRE COUNCIL MALMESBURY ST PAUL WITHOUT 13 (PART), 16 (PART) AND 17 (PART) AND LEA AND CLEVERTON 1A (PART) DIVERSION ORDER AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2015

This order is made by Wiltshire Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph 1 of this order and the public it is expedient that the lines of the paths should be diverted.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the Malmesbury Rural District Council area definitive map and statement dated 1952 require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversions (as authorised by this order) of the highways shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

The applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Malmesbury St Paul Without Parish Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act;

BY THIS ORDER:

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- 1. The public rights of way over land situated at Southfield Farm, Malmesbury St Paul Without and shown by bold continuous lines on the map contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this order, and thereupon the Malmesbury Rural District Council area definitive map dated 1952 shall be modified by deleting from it those public rights of way.
- 2. There shall be at the date of certification of the new footpaths over the land situate at Southfield Farm, Malmesbury St Paul Without described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by broken lines on the map contained in this order
- 3. The Malmesbury Rural Council area definitive statements dated 1952 shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule to this order.
