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# Confirmation funding and overall expenditure limits for Discretionary Housing Payments in 2013/14

### Introduction

 Following some inquiries from local authorities (LA) we are issuing this circular to provide clarity on the arrangements for 2013/14 Discretionary Housing Payment (DHP) funding and to set out the revised overall expenditure limit for each authority.

### **DHP** funding

- 2. In January 2013, we issued circular <u>HB S1/2013</u>, which notified LAs of their government contribution towards DHPs in 2013/14; and the overall expenditure limit. Since then there have been changes in the funding that has been made available to some LAs due to a correction in the allocation methodology affecting Scotland and additional funding for the most sparsely populated LAs. This led to the issue of circular HB S6/2013 in July 2013 notifying LAs of their revised limits.
- 3. Further DHP awards have since been made based on bids for the additional £20 million fund that was made available. The scheme closed on 3 February 2014 and all awards have been paid to the successful LAs.
- 4. Appendix A sets out the total funding that we made available to each LA, and the final overall expenditure limit. In addition it also details those LAs who received money from the £20 million reserve fund and the amount they received.

## Amendment to legislation

5. An amendment to the 'Discretionary Housing Payments (Grants) Order 2001' will be made with retroactive effect from April 2013, to clarify that the overall 2.5 times expenditure limit will be based on total central government contributions awarded for the year in question, rather than the contribution awarded at the start of the year.
