Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is **10 October 2016**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a length of restricted byway in the former Haltemprice Urban District commencing on the northern side of Springfield Way, west of No. 22 at Grid Reference TA 0441 2882 (Point A on the map) and leading northerly for some 375 metres to join Springfield Lane, south of No. 20 at Grid Reference TA 0440 2919 (Point B on the map).

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 24 October 2016]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's

offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 05 December 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 16 January 2017]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order(s) must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

This Order is made by The East Riding of Yorkshire Council under section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ('the Act') because it appears to that authority that the Humberside County Council East Yorkshire Borough of Beverley Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(c)(i) of the Act, namely the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a restricted byway.

The authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The East Riding of Yorkshire Council hereby order that:

1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 10 March 2016.
2. The Humberside County Council East Yorkshire Borough of Beverley Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way shall be modified as described in Part I and II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as 'The East Riding of Yorkshire Council (Former Haltemprice Urban District Restricted Byway No. 50) Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order 2016.'

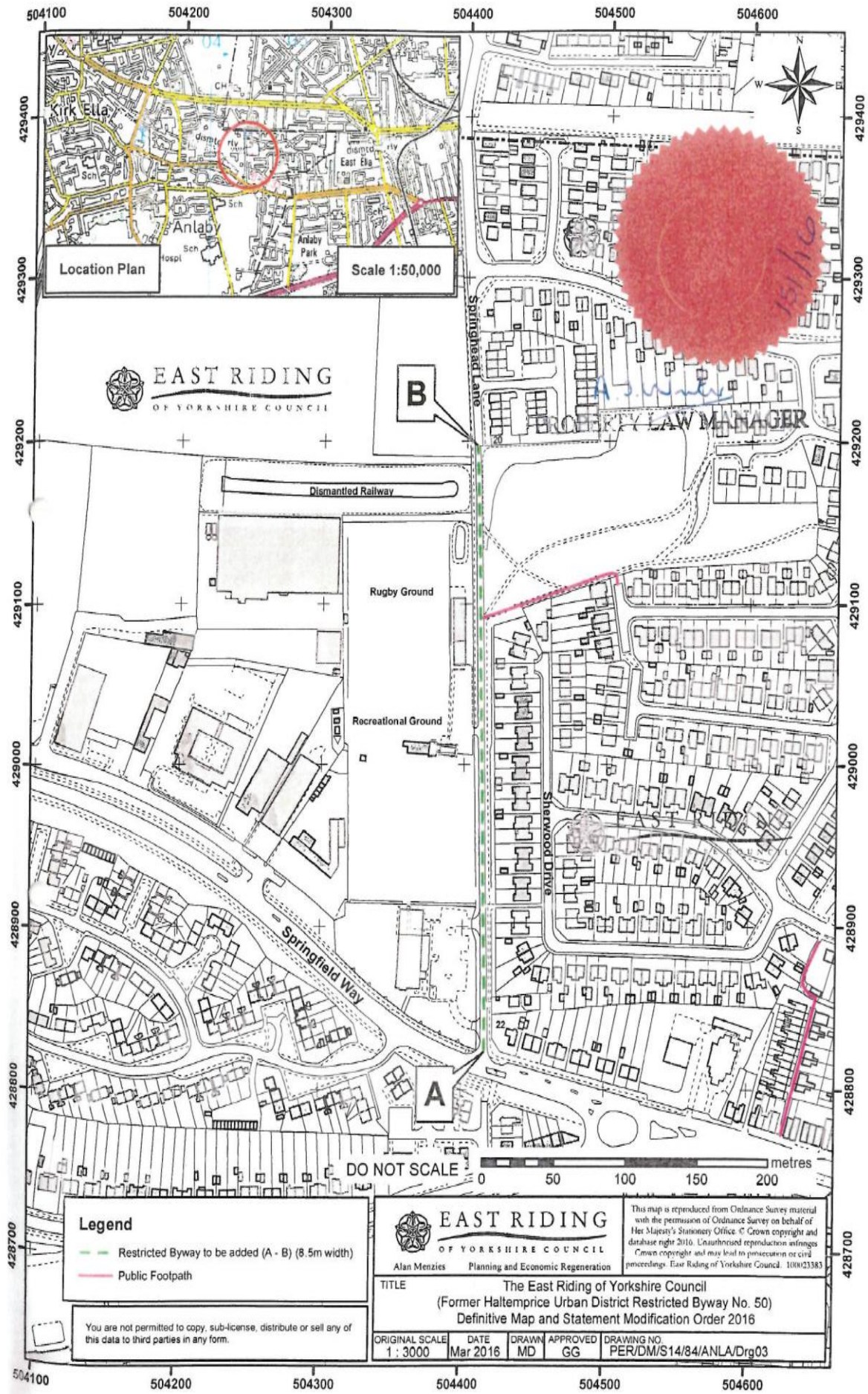

MODIFICATION OF DEFINITIVE MAP

Description of path or way to be added

A length of restricted byway in the Former Haltemprice Urban District commencing on the northern side of Springfield Way west of No. 22 Springfield Way at Grid Reference TA 0441 2882 (Point A on the map) and leading northerly for some 375 metres to join Springhead Lane south of No. 20 at Grid Reference TA 0440 2919 (Point B on the map).

The restricted byway will have a width of 8.5 metres. A gate and bollards create a pinch point of 1.6 metres at Grid Reference 0440 2919 (Point B on the map).
