As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

## Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 16 January 2017]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order(s) must do so in line with the timetable set out above.


## Description of path or way to be added

A length of restricted byway in the Former Haltemprice Urban District commencing on the northern side of Springfield Way west of No. 22 Springfield Way at Grid Reference TA 0441 2882 (Point A on the map) and leading northerly for some 375 metres to join Springhead Lane south of No. 20 at Grid Reference TA 0440 2919 (Point B on the map).

The restricted byway will have a width of 8.5 metres. A gate and bollards create a pinch point of 1.6 metres at Grid Reference 0440 2919 (Point B on the map).
