

Notice to the Office of the Public Guardian of an objection to registration of a lasting power of attorney

You use this form to tell the Office of the Public Guardian (OPG) about your objection to the Court of Protection ('the court') about a lasting power of attorney (LPA) registration. OPG and the court are different organisations. You need to tell OPG within three weeks of the date you are sent an 'LP3 form', which tells you an LPA is going to be registered. If you don't tell OPG, it may go ahead and register the LPA.
