Footpath Felling 15 – From Point B on the order map grid reference NZ29776296 from its junction with Footpath Felling 16, Footpath Felling 15 proceeds in a south easterly direction for approximately 98 metres to its junction with the tarmac path, which runs to the rear of Marion Drive at Point C on the order map grid reference NZ29856290, with an undefined width throughout.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 28 February 2017]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State.
