1 Introductions & review o/s actions

Actions 1 – 4 documented below

Q on R&D on the Estate. SLC specific requirements handled by SLC, speculative R&D handled by NDA & Innovate UK. Information shared between groups.

2 Intellectual Property - Alex Smith, Sellafield

Explanation given on flowdowns. Plan to rationalise flowdowns further.

3 Sellafield /SSA - Robert Astall, Commercial Director

End of reprocessing on SL means Thorp will close in 3-4 years therefore focus will change to decommissioning. Development on going to transform SL with a reduction in direct employees over the next few years to a supply chain led balance giving a more agile aim to work.

External strategic (transformation)partners will be focusing on supporting the 23 programmes, looking for the value streams. Programme & Project Delivery Partner is being recruited to support SL on delivering Project Management, Project Controls and Commercial. Market research and tech dialogue completed, next step to complete Governance & approach the market shortly.

Spend stats show £72m direct SME spend over 2015/16. Breakdown is 36% Cumbrian SMEs, 12% North West and 52% rest of UK.

RG added that suppliers must be agile and prepared to work in other Decomm industries and locations in future.

4 SSA – RG

SSA now recruiting 16 full time members to drive the changes to Collaborative Procurement. Aim to bring standardisation to supply chain of PQQs, quality standards, bonds, insurances, contracts etc. SSA will also be subject to the Pan-Estate SME Agenda to published by NDA in November.

5 NDA Update – RG

Key topics in Gov – SMEs, Growth and Skills. Gov target for SME over this parliament remains 33%, NDA target 31%. New target for Gov depts. to achieve 3m new apprentices by 2020, NDA in discussion over how to implement this with shrinking workforce, whether this can be extended into the supply chain. Following Gov reshuffle, NDA report to BEIS (Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy).











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Changes within NDA include retirement of John Clarke during 2017, change to Chairman – Stephen Henwood who has reached the end of 2nd term with NDA and Peter Lutwyche who will be moving back to Jacobs this year.

Update on litigation with Energy Solutions – NDA seeking leave to Appeal with Supreme court.

7 Sellafield Supply Chain Coalition (SSCC) – Chris George, Amec FW

Chris George presented details of a tool developed by the group to enable companies applying for work at Sellafield to ensure they understand and meet the best practice required. 8 Tier2 Governance Group – Socio Economic sub group

Group are looking at how to improve the methods of supporting SME involvement and are looking at methods to share information and best practice. Presentation will be circulated.

Discussion progressed to methods of advertising opportunities – NDA working on methods to include Tier2 tender opportunities on CTM (Contract Tender Management). This avoids costs being incurred by the supply chain from using 3rd party systems.
