

Governance

The Government ICT applies to all of the UK public sector, whether central government, local government, wider public sector or devolved administration. The Prime Minister set the Chief Information Officers (CIO) Council members and their staff the mission of “ensuring that IT supports the business transformation of Government itself so that we can provide better, more efficient, public services.” The CIO Council has agreed an integrated governance structure that combines Chief Information Officers, central government, technical, commercial and local government/wider public sector expertise. The structure has been agreed for ICT delivery as a whole, as well as for each of the 14 workstrands. The CIO Council has agreed the following principal roles and their responsibilities.
