You are encouraged to use and re-use the Information that is made available under this licence by the MOD freely and flexibly, with only a few conditions. You must read this Licence in full and understand and abide by the terms contained herein to be able to use the Information made available to you.

Using Information under this licence

Use by You of copyright material limited to photographs, film footage, or both, which has been expressly made available to You under this licence (the 'Information') indicates Your acceptance of the terms and conditions below.

The MOD grants to You a worldwide, royalty-free, perpetual, non-exclusive licence to use the Information subject to the conditions below:

This licence DOES have limitations on copyright exceptions including fair dealing because of its content.

Licence Restrictions:

- Individuals shown in the Information have given their consent in writing; to these licence terms being acceptable to them subject to there being: No actual or potential defamatory, libellous or otherwise unlawful Use by You or to any other party to whom You pass or otherwise make the Information available to, nor any Use in any way or manner whatsoever by any political party, (howsoever formed), nor for any use in any parody, caricature and pastiche.

Definitions

In this licence, the terms below have the following meanings:

'DIPR' Means Defence Intellectual Property Rights, the only part of the MOD with delegation to deal with intellectual property and grant licences to third parties or otherwise set terms of Use for Information.

'Information' means information protected by copyright or by database right (for example, literary and artistic works, content, data and source code) offered for use under the terms of this licence.

'Information Provider' means the person or organisation providing the Information under this licence.

'MOD' means the Ministry of Defence, which in this context acts as an information provider which has the authority to offer Information under the terms of this licence who has the authority to offer Information subject to Crown copyright and Crown database rights and Information subject to

copyright and database right that has been created by the MOD's staff, or assigned to or acquired by the Crown.
