Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert that part of Public Footpath No.3 in the Parish of North Hykeham running from Public Bridleway No.2 at Point E on the Order Map (grid reference: SK 9306 6562) in a northerly direction for 335 metres to a Kissing Gate on Newark Road (Point A on the Order Map (grid reference: SK 9304 6595). The total length of footpath to be diverted to be approximately 335 metres AND TO create an alternative footpath in the parish of North Hykeham to be two metres in width, running from Public Bridleway No.2 at Point D (grid reference: SK 9307 6561) in a northnorth-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 49 metres to Point C (grid reference: SK 9309 6567) and continuing in a generally northerly direction for approximately 275 metres to Point B (grid reference: SK 9307 6595). The footpath then turns in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 33 metres to a Kissing Gate on Newark Road at Point A (grid reference: SK 9304 6595) where it joins the existing route of Footpath No.3. The total length of footpath to be added to be approximately 357 metres.

PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990, SECTION 257

NORTH KESTEVEN (NEWARK ROAD, NORTH HYKEHAM) (FOOTPATH NO. 3) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016

This order is made by North Kesteven District Council under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to divert the footpath to which this order relates in order to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 namely, Phase 6 of development at Newark Road, North Hykeham.

BY THIS ORDER

- 1. The footpath over the land shown by a bold black line on the attached map and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order ("the Schedule") shall be diverted as provided below.
- 2. There shall be created to the reasonable satisfaction of the North Kesteven District Council an alternative highway for use as a replacement for the said footpath as provided in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by bold broken black line on the attached map.
- 3. The diversion of the footpath shall have effect on the date on which North Kesteven District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 above have been complied with.
- 4. The following works shall be carried out in relation to the highway described in Part 2 of the Schedule, namely provision shall be made for the new path within a 2 metre wide corridor.
- 5. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had. The order shall come into force when it is certified by the North Kesteven District Council that the said works have been completed.

PART 1

Description of site of existing path

That part of Public Footpath No. 3 in the Parish of North Hykeham running from Public Bridleway No. 2 at Point E on the Order Map (grid reference: SK 9306 6562) in a northerly direction for 335 metres to a Kissing Gate on Newark Road (Point A on the Order Map (grid reference: SK 9304 6595). The total length of footpath to be diverted to be approximately 335 metres as shown between points E-A on the annexed Order Map.

PART 2

Description of site of alternative highway

A footpath in the parish of North Hykeham to be two metres in width, running from Public Bridleway No. 2 at Point D (grid reference: SK 9307 6561) in a north-north-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 49 metres to Point C (grid reference: SK 9309 6567) and continuing in a generally northerly direction for approximately 275 metres to Point B (grid reference: SK 9307 6595). The footpath then turns in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 33 metres to a Kissing Gate on Newark Road at Point A (grid reference: SK 9304 6595) where it joins the existing route of Footpath No. 3. The total length of footpath to be added to be approximately 357 metres as shown between points D-C-B-A on the annexed Order Map.
