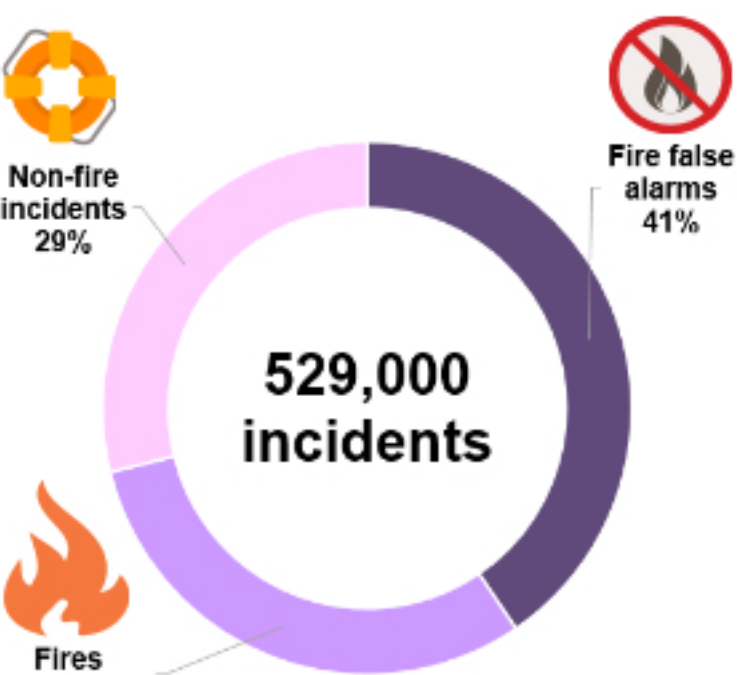
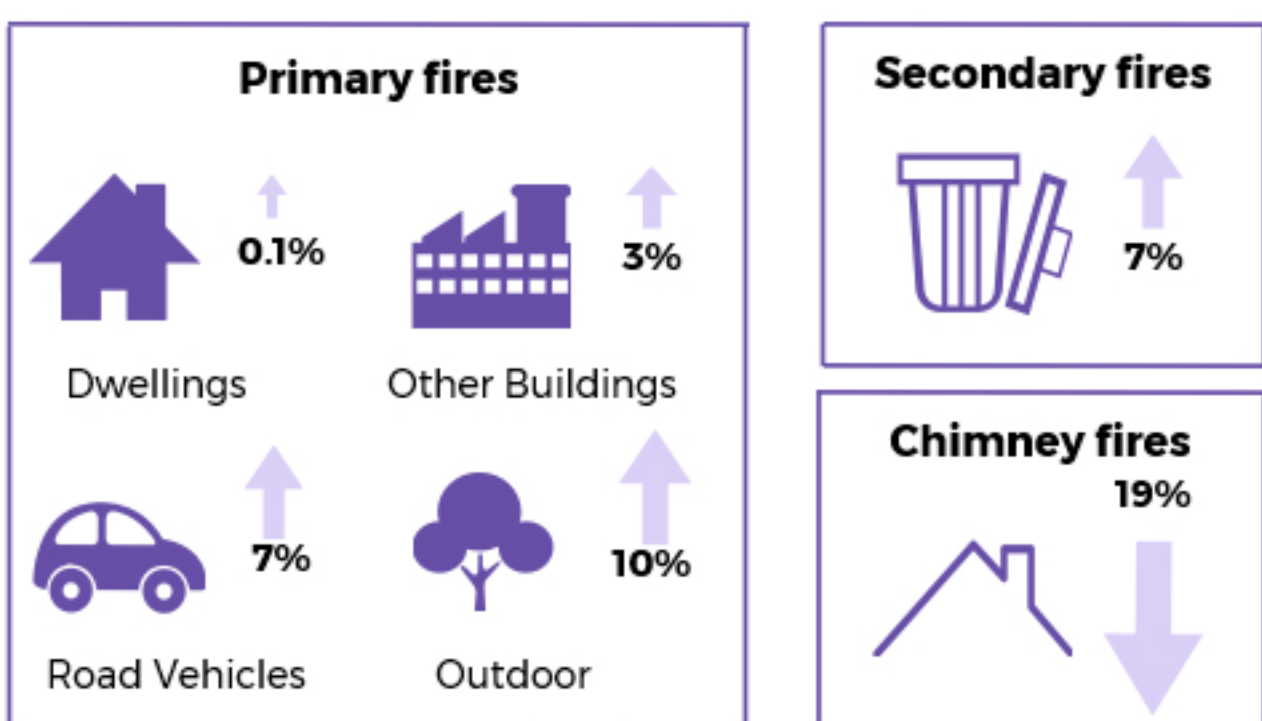

All incidents attended by fire and rescue services 2015/16



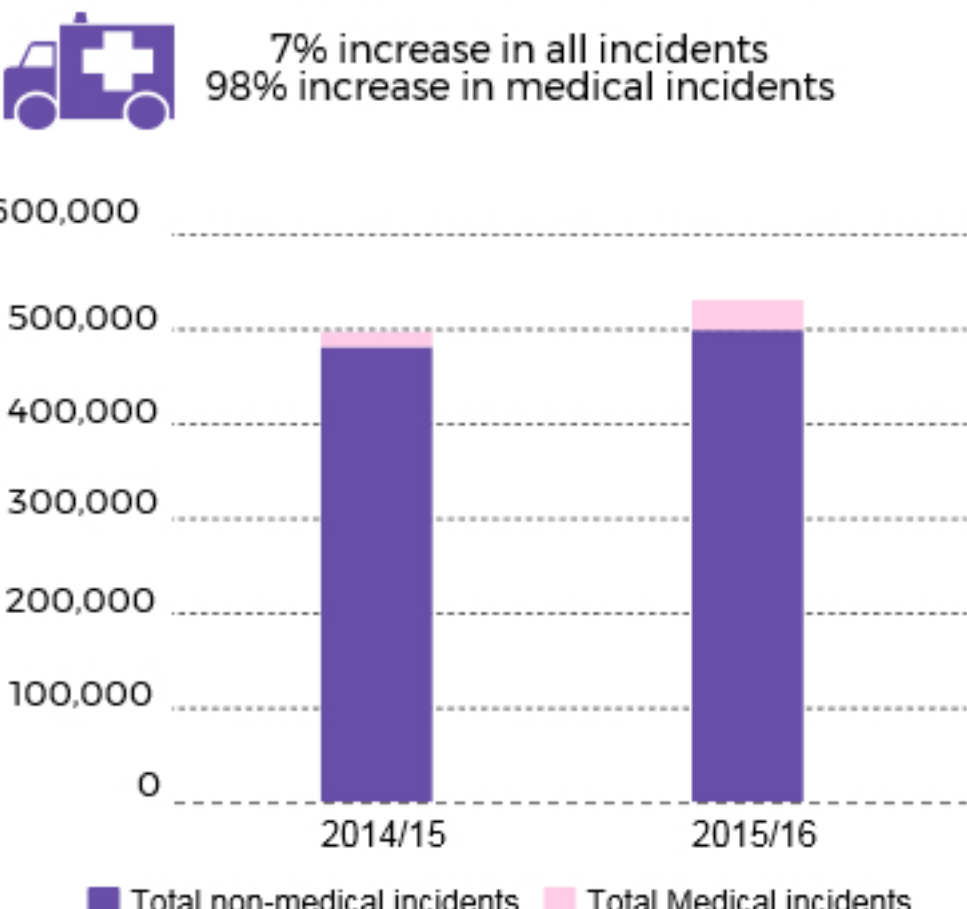
Changes in the number of fires attended by fire and rescue services, 2015/16 compared with 2014/15



Changes in total incidents and fires attended 2014/15 to 2015/16

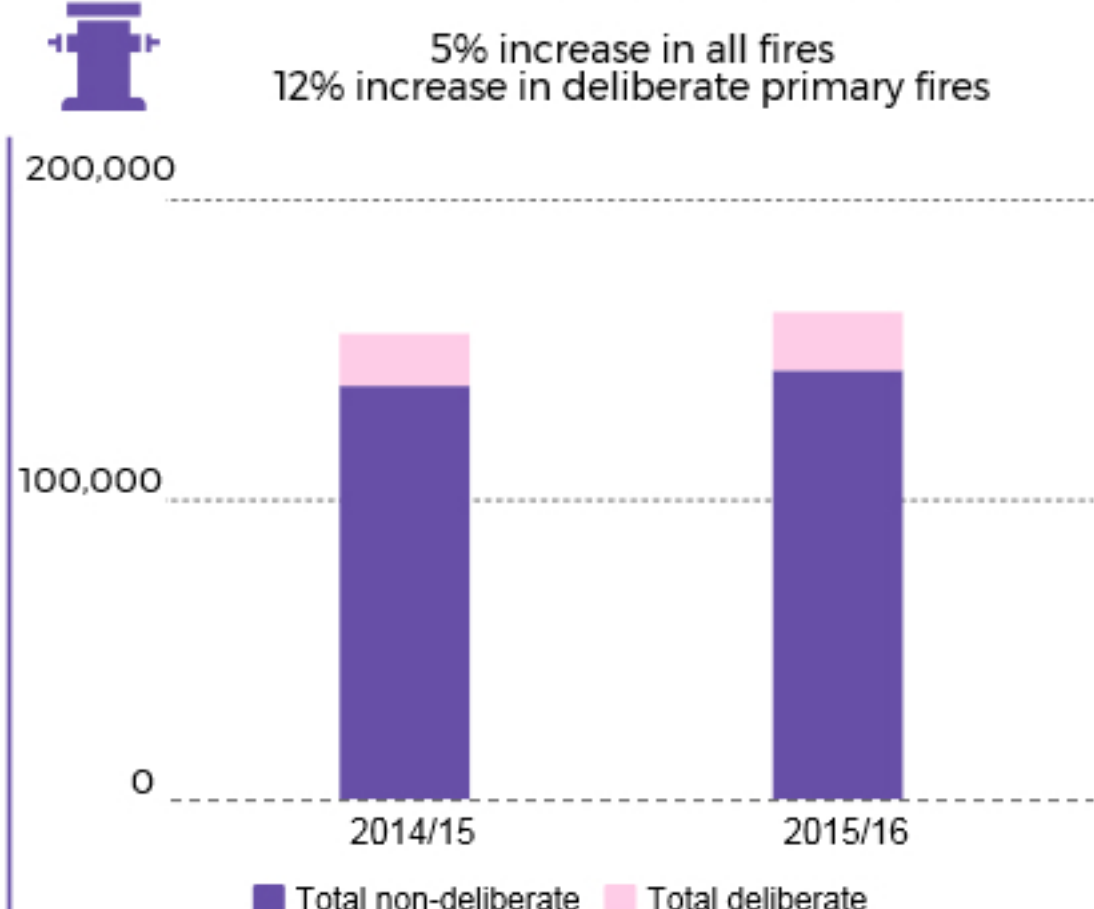
Medical incidents attended

98% increase in medical incidents



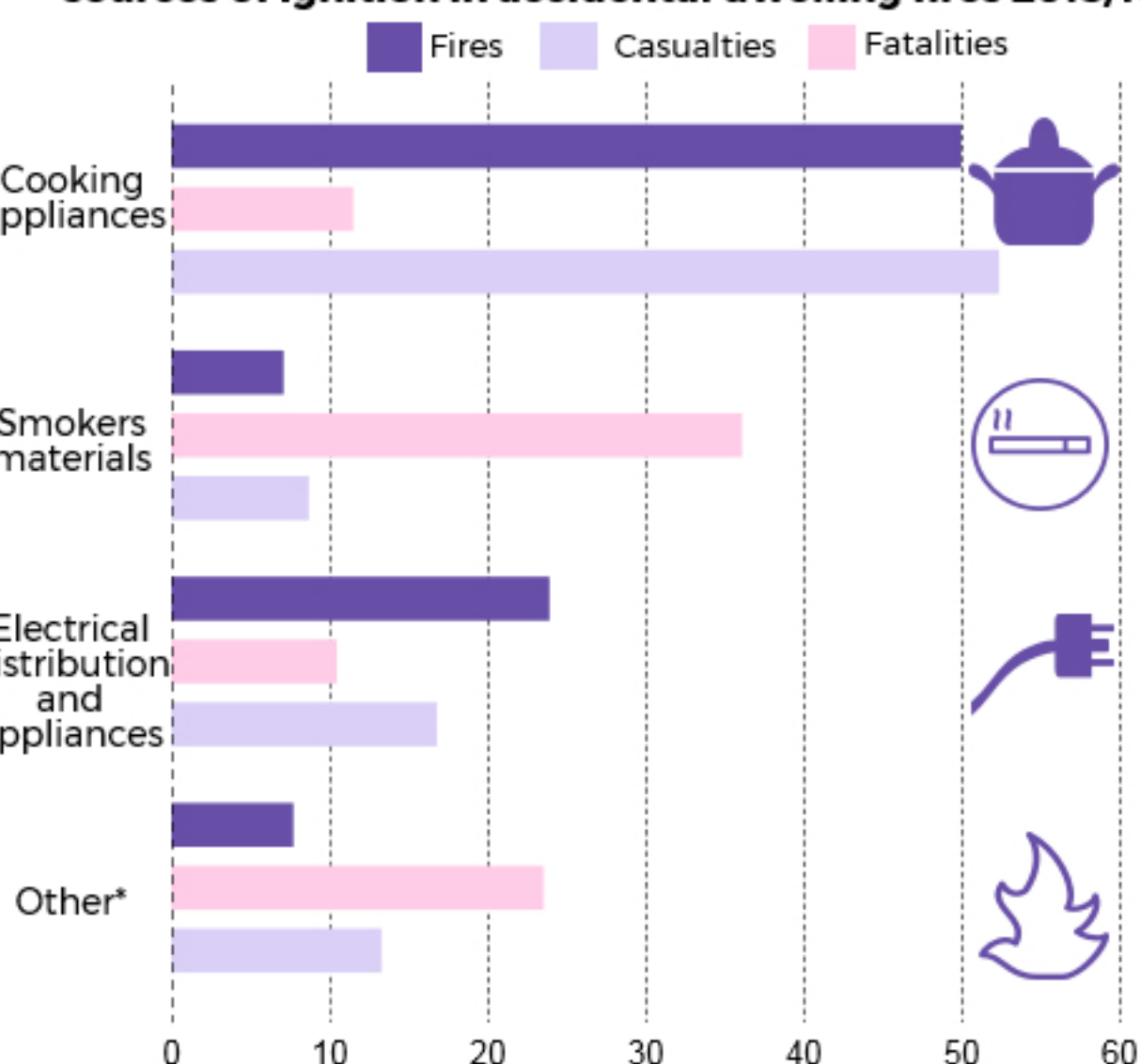
Primary fires attended

12% increase in deliberate primary fires

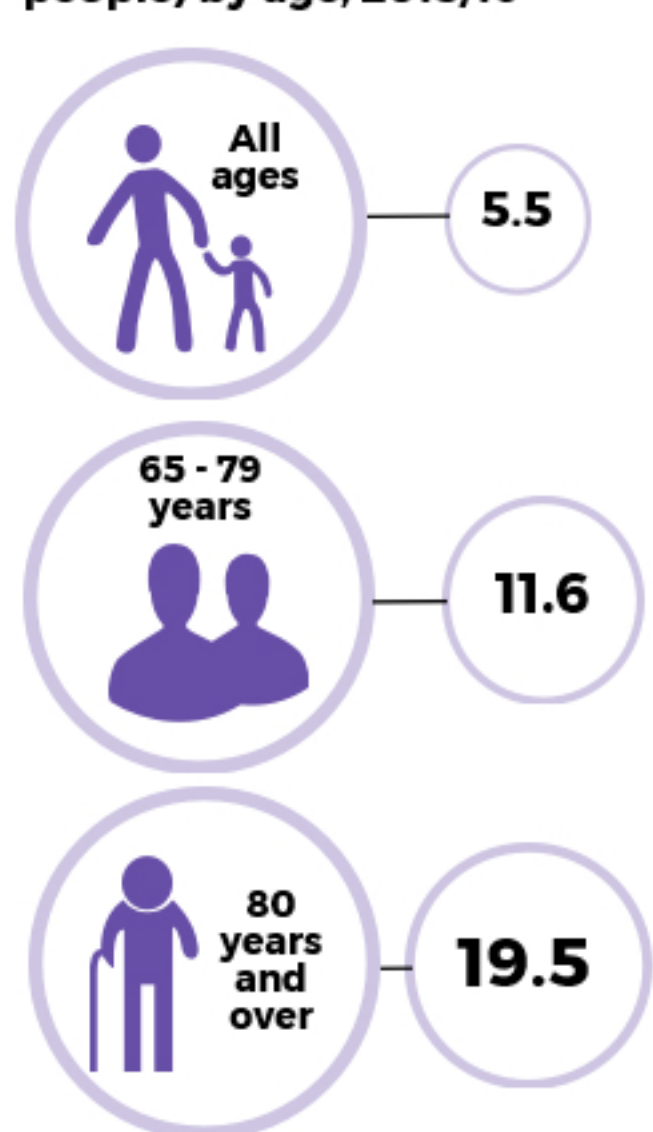


Fire-related fatalities and casualties

Smoke alarm ownership and operation

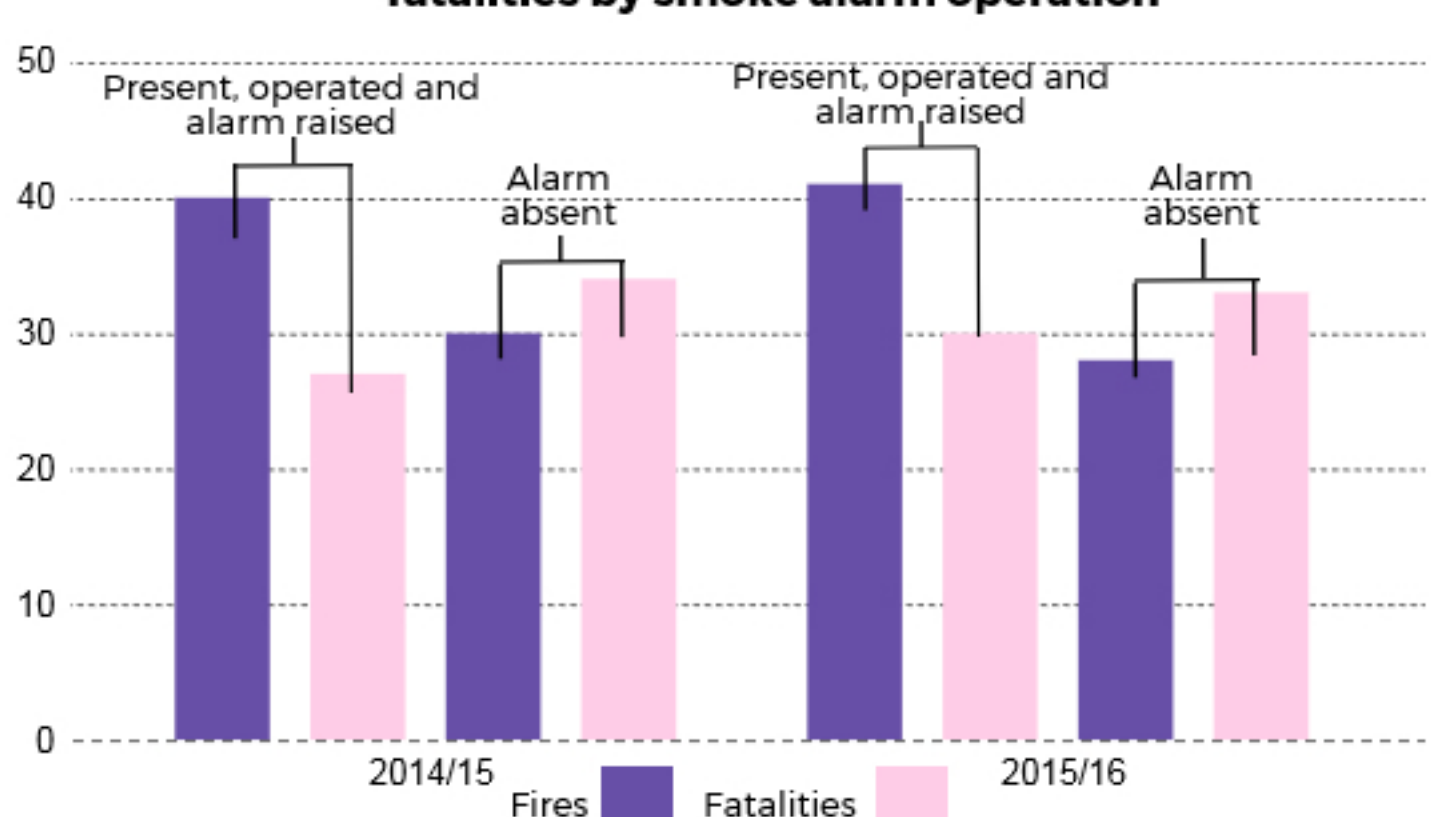

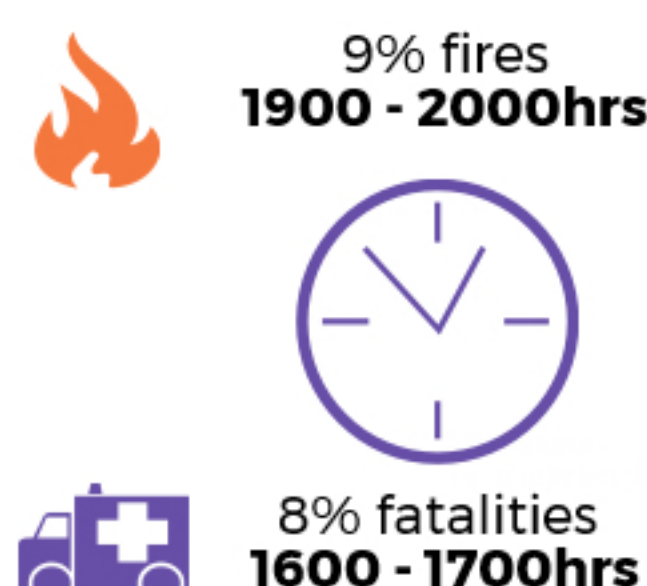

The proportion of dwelling fires and dwelling fire fatalities by smoke alarm operation

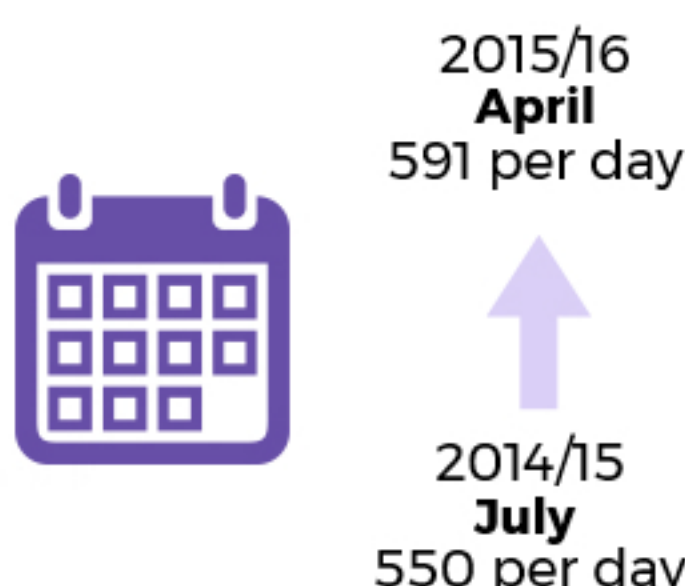


Temporal and seasonal fire analyses
