at least one upper strap (20, x20, x62, 7512) configured to extend above the patient's ear and at least one lower strap (30, x30, x64, x13, 7514) configured to extend below the patient's ear. the upper and/or lower straps (20, x20, x62, 7512, 30, x30, x 30, x64, x13, 7514) configured to removably connect the first strap (x10) to the mask (10);

characterised in that the at least one upper strap (20, x20, x62, 7512) is more extensible than the at least one lower strap (30, x30, x64, x13, 7514).

## Claim 1

A headgear for use with a mask (10), comprising:

the upper and/or lower straps (20, x20, x62, 7512, 30, x30, x 30, x64, x13, 7514) configured to removably connect the first strap (x10) to the mask (10);

characterised in that the at least one <u>lower strap (30, x30, x64, x13, 7514)</u> is made from a <u>material with lower extensibility than that of the at least one</u> upper strap (20, x20, x62, 7512) is more extensible than the at least one lower strap (30, x30, x64, x13, 7514).
