The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert the public footpath 1.2 m wide shown by a bold solid line on the plan annexed hereto commencing at its junction with Woodhouse Crescent at point A on the plan at map reference 3858 2168 proceeding in an southerly direction for 101 metres to its junction with Queen Elizabeth Drive at point C on the plan at map reference 3859 2158 with a spur commencing at point B at grid reference 3859 2160 proceeding easterly then southerly for 48 metres to its junction with Queen Elizabeth Drive at point D at grid reference 3862 2158 to a 2.0 metre wide public footpath shown by the bold dashed line on the plan annexed hereto commencing at its junction with Woodhouse Crescent at point A on the plan at map reference 3858 2168 proceeding in a south westerly direction for 116 metres thence easterly for 58 metres to its junction with Queen Elizabeth Drive at point C at map reference 3859 2158 continuing to point D at grid reference 3862 2158 then continuing in an easterly direction for 61 metres thence north westerly for 154 metres to its junction Woodhouse Crescent at point A on the plan at map reference 3858 2168.

The above order, when confirmed, will also modify the Council of the City of Wakefield Definitive Map and Statement by deleting from it the path or way referred to in paragraph 1 of the of the order and the definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 3 of the Schedule to the order.

Within 12 weeks of the start date [by 14 November 2017]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Hearing must ensure their statement of case¹ is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.

This order is made by The Council of the City of Wakefield under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interest of the landowner it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears that the Council of the City of Wakefield Definitive Map & Statement requires modification in consequence of an occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely the diversion (as authorised by this order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public footpath over the land situated at Normanton and shown by a solid bold line on the map contained in the Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on confirmation of this Order.
- 2. There shall be on the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land at Normanton described in Part II of the Schedule and shown by a bold dashed line on the map contained in this Order.
- 3. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.
- 5. The definitive map and statement shall be modified as described in Part III of the Schedule to this Order.
