Government badger control costs 2015

August 2016

Background

On 28 August 2015, Defra announced that as part of its measured approach to tackling bovine TB and achieving disease control benefits, Natural England had licensed and authorised local farmers and landowners to carry out targeted badger control in Gloucestershire, Somerset and Dorset in 2015.

Operations took place from 31 August 2015 to 12 October 2015 in Somerset and Dorset and from 2 September 2015 to 14 October 2015 in Gloucestershire.

Badger control costs

Information on costs to Government in 2013, 2014 and 2015 is provided in Table 1 below.
