

Countryside Stewardship Mid Tier advice 2017

one-to-one sessions

In addition to the Mid Tier events, you also have the opportunity to book a free one-to-one session with an Adviser for help with your application. To attend a session you must have received your application paperwork and be ready to discuss preferred options and capital works. These sessions are for farmers and land managers – you may be accompanied by an agent if you wish but the agent cannot attend on your behalf.

You can attend a second free one-to-one session if you would like help with checking a completed application before submitting. These appointments are to ensure you have completed the paperwork correctly, that you have all the necessary supporting evidence in place and that you fully understand the requirements and restrictions of your chosen options.
