The importance of developing the library workforce

One of the Libraries Taskforce's actions was to produce a Public Library Skills Strategy. This was created by SCL and CILIP and published on the CILIP website in July 2017.

Libraries: Opportunities for Everyone (LOFE) Innovation Fund providing people with opportunities they might not otherwise have.
