WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53

Essex County Council Definitive Map Modification No. 617 Footpath 59 Nazeing (Epping Forest District) Order 2016

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. Following an earlier hearing, the Inspector appointed to determine the Order issued a letter in which he proposed to make modifications to the Order as drafted. Following advertisement of those proposals objections/representations have been received.

The **start date** for the above Order is 6 October 2017.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case which contain evidence in respect of the Inspector's proposed modifications only.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications will be to modify the Definitive Map for the area by:-

- 1. Adding a length of Footpath 59 Nazeing, from Waltham Road (Nazeing Long Green) at the western boundary of the property known as "Selways" in a north-north-westerly direction for a distance of 70 metres then turning north-east for a distance of 55 metres to join the unaffected part of the route. The width of the added section is four feet (1.22 metres)
- 2. Deleting a length of Footpath 59 Nazeing from a point D on the order plan in a south-south-easterly direction for a distance of 70 metres to meet Waltham Road at Point A.

The effect of the proposed modifications would be to:

- Delete all of the text relating to the provisions of Section 53(3)(c)(iii) of the 1981 Act.
- Insert after "route" in the fourth line of the first description in Part I of the Order Schedule, "The footpath proceeds along the western and northern boundaries of the land held within Land Registry Title Number EX292306 (points G-B-H on the attached map). It then continues along the southern boundary of the land immediately to the north of registered Title Number EX292306 (points H-D on the attached map)".
- Delete the second description in Part I of the Order Schedule.
- Delete the solid line shown on the Order Map between points A-D and amend the map key accordingly.

As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications, the applicant and any other person who has previously written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 12 January 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the above date, the Secretary of State will send copies of the comments received to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Orders must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties <u>everyone should keep to the timetable</u> to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time.

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.

Modification of Definitive Map

Description of path or way to be added:

A length of Footpath 59 Nazeing, from Waltham Road (Nazeing Long Green) at the western boundary of the property known as "Selways" in a north north westerly direction for a distance of 70 metres then turning north east for a distance of 55 metres to join the unaffected part of the route. The width of the added section is four feet (1.22 metres)

Description of path or way to be deleted:

A length of Footpath 59 Nazeing from a point D on the order plan in a southsouth- easterly direction for a distance of 70 metres to meet the Waltham Road at Point A.

PART II

Modifications of Definitive Statement

Variations of particulars of path or way

The statement for the parish of Nazeing shall be amended to read as follows:

OS Sheet No.	Path No.	Classification	Position and Description
40 NW, SW 4005- 4004	59	FΡ	From Middle Street and the access track to the dwellings of Bumbles Green Farm leading south -westwards adjacent to and on the north side of the ditch to a culvert where it deviates around a large tree over the culvert. Then immediately re-joining the north side of the ditch to a point opposite the property known as Jamesmead, approximately 220 mt south-west of Middle Road. Up to this point the path has a width of 1.5 mt and shall be no less than 1 metre from the brow of the ditch. Then continuing in the same direction to a point approximately 226 metres south-west of Middle Street . This section has a width of 1.5 mt and shall be no less than 2mt from the brow of the ditch, on the north side of the ditch. Then continuing, at a width of 1.22 metres in a south westerly direction for a distance of 35 metres, before crossing the boundary on to Selways where it continues in the same direction for 20 metres. It then turns south- south- east along the western boundary of Selways for a distance of 70 metres to meet the Waltham Road.
