2. There were no substantive updates following the MAC meeting on 7 July.

Agenda item 4 - Paper 95.1: MAC data analysis

3. The MAC considered the latest version of a paper updating data analysis in relation to EU workers in the UK. The MAC decided that this analysis should form the basis of a briefing paper to be issued along with a call for evidence in the event of the MAC receiving a commission including EU workers.

Agenda item 5 - Paper 95.2: MAC Commission Stakeholder Strategy

- 4. Stephen Earl presented a paper considering options for a strategy to engage with stakeholders in the event of a MAC commission. The MAC were invited to suggest additions to the strategy. The MAC suggested ways of identifying and securing engagement across a wider field of stakeholders and also considered the relevance of previous MAC work. The possibility of commissioning research was also considered.
- 5. The MAC asked that the strategy pay particular attention to areas where data was less strong, such as in sectors that made greater use of self-employed workers, as well identifying occupations and jobs that may be more amenable to the introduction of new technology. The MAC also asked that there be a focus on skills and training in the strategy to encourage stakeholders to provide evidence on these
