Thank you for your email of 27 July in which you requested the following information:

'How much does a single L85a2 with sights and all other equipment attached to the rifle cost and what combat gear are soldiers issued'

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000.

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held. Some information from your request is exempt under Section 21 of the FOIA, because it is reasonably accessible to you by other means. I can however confirm that the costs (excluding VAT) for the SA80A2 are:

SA80A2 Basic fit – approximately £1,000 SA80A2 Equipped to fight (does not include night sight) – approximately £4,000

Under section 16 of the FOI Act, it may be helpful for you to know that purchase prices vary depending on quantities ordered, and the figures above relate to the most recent purchase.
