1. Introduction

This document is a guide to the registration of suppliers from the implementation of Council Directive 2008/90/EC and its Commission Implementing Directives 2014/96/EC, 2014/97/EC and 2014/98/EC.

2. Supplier registration

Any grower engaged in the marketing of plants covered by Council Directive 2008/90/EC will need to be registered with APHA.

If you are a supplier with a current Plant Passport number you will be automatically registered. If you are a supplier who markets plants but does not have a current Plant Passport number you must apply to APHA for registration.
