From the existing path:

From the unaffected part of Footpath 10, south of Priory View at ST 91190541, north west, through a garden gate and through the garden of Camelot to ST 91170243, then turning south west and continuing through the garden to rejoin the unaffected part of Footpath 10 at ST 91160242. Width between ST 91170243 and ST 91160242 - 5 feet (1.5 metres).

To a new path:

From the unaffected part of Footpath 10, south of Priory View at ST 91190241, south west along a double fenced path to ST 91170240, then turning north west and continuing along the path, passing to the west of the garden of Camelot, to rejoin the unaffected part of Footpath 10 at ST 91160242. Width: The width of this part of Footpath 10 is 2 metres.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 3 April 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 15 May 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties <u>everyone should keep to the timetable</u> to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

Public Path Diversion and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order

Highways Act 1980 Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981

Dorset County Council (Part of Footpath 10, Spetisbury) Public Path Diversion Order 2017

This Order is made by Dorset County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the 1981 Act") because it appears to the authority that the County of Dorset definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

Mr Simon Lauder has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Spetisbury Parish Council and North Dorset District Council have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the land situate at Spetisbury and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 7 days from the date of confirmation of this order or on the date which Dorset County Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highway mentioned in article 3 into a fit condition for use by the public, whichever is the later and thereupon the County of Dorset definitive map shall be modified by deleting from it that public right of way.
- Notwithstanding this order Scottish and Southern Electricity shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely: full and free access for purposes connected to the use and maintenance of their apparatus now existing under, over or on the land referred to in paragraph 1.
- 3. There shall at the end of 7 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situate at Spetisbury described in Part 2 of the Schedule to this Order and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this order and thereupon the County of Dorset definitive map shall be modified by adding that path to it.
- The County of Dorset definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the Schedule to this Order.
