Following an earlier hearing, the Inspector appointed to determine the Order issued a letter in which she proposed to make modifications to the Order as drafted. Following advertisement of those proposals objections / representations have been received.

The **start date** for the above Order is **16 January 2018.**

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case which contain evidence in respect of the Inspector's proposed modifications only.

The effect of the proposed modifications(s) would be to modify the Order by providing for the following modifications:

- All references in the Order and on the Order plan to 'restricted byway' to be deleted and replaced by references to 'bridleway'.
- The notation of the route on the Order plan to be amended to show the symbol for a bridleway as far as is practicable.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding a restricted byway commencing at a junction with Doiley Bottom and Slade Bottom Road (Point A at Grid Reference SU 4078 5227) and proceeding in a generally south-easterly then south westerly direction to a junction with Binley Bottom (Point B at Grid Reference SU 4091 5180), with a variable width of 4.5 and 10 metres for a total distance of 515 metres as shown on Order map

Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modification(s), the applicant and any other person who has previously written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 24 April 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modification(s), the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the above date, the Secretary of State will send copies of the comments received to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order(s) must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties <u>everyone should keep to the timetable</u> to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time.
