

# NOTICE OF ORDER

## WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53

Leicestershire County Council  
Deletion of Footpath C50A School Lane Houghton on the Hill Definitive Map  
Modification Order 2017

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is 31 January 2018.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of a hearing.

The Hearing will be held at the **Executive Meeting Room, Floor 1 County Hall, Glenfield, Leicestershire LE3 8RA** on **Wednesday 13 June 2018** at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications will be to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by deleting Footpath C50A which extends from a point situated at its junction with the south-eastern end of School Lane at Grid Reference 46761 30325 in generally easterly and south-easterly directions through two fields for a distance of approximately 330 metres to its termination at Grid Reference 46786 30307 as shown on the Order Map.

### **Timetable for sending in statements of case**

#### **Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 28 March 2018]**

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the

Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

**Within 12 weeks of the start date [by 25 April 2018]**

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Hearing must ensure their statement of case<sup>1</sup> is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

**All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.**

DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2017

This Order is made by Leicestershire County Council (hereinafter called "the Authority") under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (hereinafter called "the Act"), because it appears to that Authority that the Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Leicestershire require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Section 53(3)(c)(iii) namely the discovery by the surveying authority of evidence which (when considered with all relevant evidence available to the surveying authority) shows that there is no public right of way over land shown in the map and statement as a highway of any description, or any other particulars contained in the map and statement require modification.

The Authority have consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the Order relates. The Authority hereby order that:-

1. For the purpose of this Order the relevant date is 25<sup>th</sup> November 2016.
2. The Definitive Map and Statement for the County of Leicestershire shall be modified as described in Part I and Part II of the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.

3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the "Leicestershire County Council (Deletion of Footpath C5A, School Lane, Houghton on the Hill) Definitive Map Modification Order 2017."

Public Footpath C50A in the Parish of Houghton on the Hill and the District of Harborough shown by a solid black line on Plan No. M1021 annexed hereto which extends from Point 'A' on the plan situate at its junction with the south-eastern end of School Lane (Private Drive) at Grid Reference 46761 30325 in generally easterly and south-easterly directions through two fields for a distance of approximately 330 metres to point 'B' on the plan situate at its termination at Grid Reference 46786 30307 . (A-B as indicated on the plan).

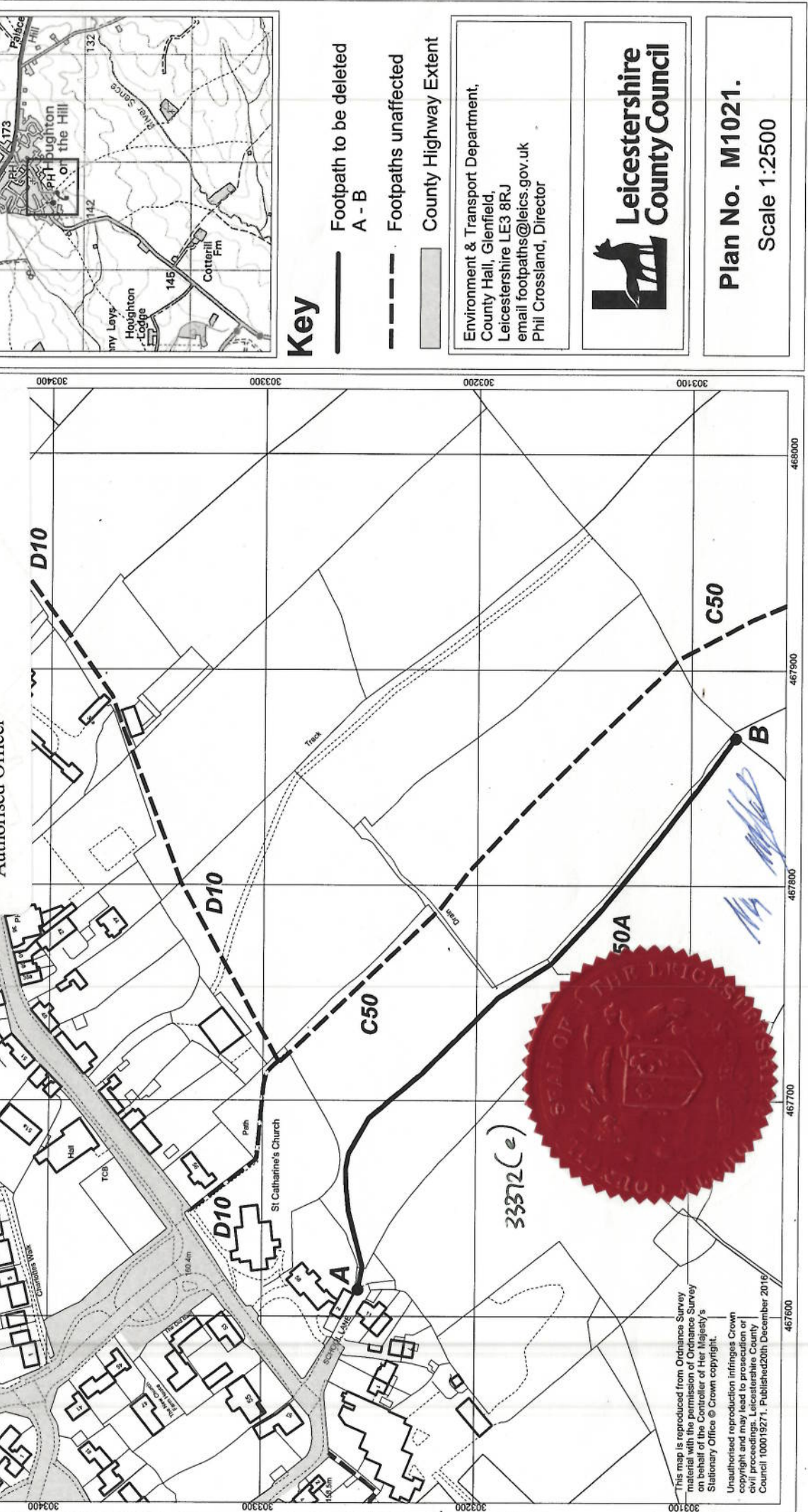




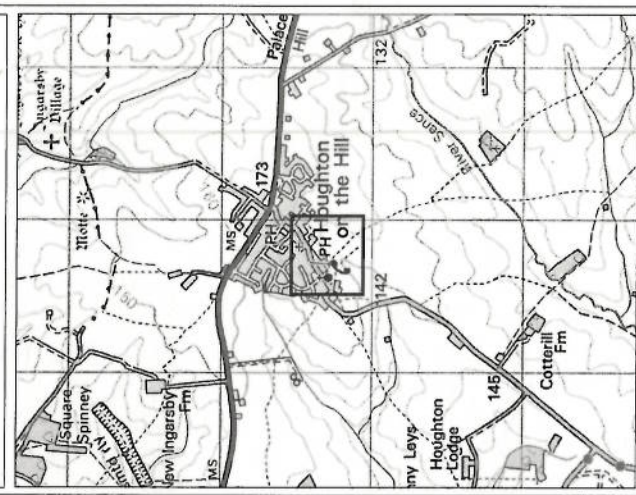
