13 Insurance

The insurance must be valid for the full duration of the registration. We do not need a copy of the insurance certificate, but we carry out sample checks on declarations.

14 Boat safety – construction and equipment standards

You must make sure your vessel complies with our construction and equipment standards at all times it is kept, used or let for hire on the Anglian Waterways.

These standards are set out in the 'BSS Examination Checking Procedures for Privately Owned and Managed Boats' and for hire boats the additional BSS Hire Boats Requirements. For other non-private boats – for example small passenger boats; shared-ownership boats managed jointly by the private owners; workboats; emergency service boats and rescue boats; hotel boats, boats let as residences or longer term accommodation – they are contained in the 'Boat Safety Scheme Guide (2002 edition)'. Go to www.boatsafetyscheme.org to download them.

I certify that the vessel complies in every respect with the safety standard requirements set out in those guides or the Recreational Craft Directive (for vessels first placed on the market since 16 June 1996). I will not keep or use this vessel on the Anglian Waterways unless these conditions are complied with.

I understand that the Environment Agency may require me to provide information confirming compliance with these conditions or to require my vessel to be inspected.

17 The Data Protection Act 1998

The Environment Agency is responsible for improvements in navigation and the registration of boats on waters for which we have responsibility. We will process the information you provide so that we can deal with your application for boat registration, make sure you keep to the conditions of the registration, and process renewals.

We may also process or release the information to:

- offer you documents or services relating to boat safety, navigation and environmental matters;
- consult the public, public organisations and other organisations (for example, the Health and Safety Executive, local authorities, the emergency services, the Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs) on boat safety, navigation and environmental issues;
- carry out research and development work on environmental issues;
- prevent anyone from breaking environmental law, investigate cases where environmental law may have been broken, and take any action that is needed;
- assess whether customers are satisfied with our service and to improve our service; and
- respond to requests for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 and the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (if the Data Protection Act 1998 allows).

We may pass the information to our agents or representatives to do these things for us.

Explanatory notes

2 Registered owner

Only **one** person or organisation may be registered as the owner.

3 Dimensions

Please enter length and beam measurements in metres and tenths. 'Length' is overall hull length excluding moveable items such as rudder or outboard engine. 'Beam' is measured at the widest part of the hull.

5 Waterway to be visited

Vessels based on or normally used on the Anglian waterways are not eligible for this short-period registration.

6 Registration period

Please note each period of validity begins and ends at midnight.

7 Manufacturer or builder

Please enter make or model, if known.

8 Propulsion

Where the main engine(s) is of the inboard/outboard type, tick the 'inboard' box.

9/10 Propellant/propulsion

Tick the appropriate box for the engine propellant in section 9, or specify another propulsion in the 'other' box in section 10.

15 Tender discount

If your main vessel is registered, a 50% discount applies to the tender. We define a tender as a small vessel or dinghy, towed or carried by another vessel.

16 Payment

Navigation Key

Vessels navigating our rivers need a navigation key, available through the Environment Agency, or one of our agents. These keys will be required to operate locks and/or provide access to facilities such as slipways.

If you have or are applying for a short-term/visitor registration then a fully refundable deposit (on return of the key and receipt) of £25.00 will be required for each key.

Registration

All vessels kept used or let for hire on the Anglian waterways are registered in accordance with the Environment Agency (Inland Waterways) Order 2010.

Annual registration application forms can be obtained from the Environment Agency (see contacts).

Payments made for short period registration of a vessel can be deducted from the charges due for any subsequent annual registration of that vessel.

Refunds are only made in certain limited cases (see www.gov.uk/register-a-boat or call for our refund guidance).

Visiting from Thames and Upper Medway Navigation waterways

Vessels which have a current annual registration issued from the above Environment Agency waterways can visit the Anglian waterways free of charge for two periods of 7 consecutive days.

If visiting from Environment Agency Thames or Upper Medway Navigation waterways and claiming your free visit, please make sure you fully complete Section 1 with the appropriate registration or licence number for the vessel to ensure you receive your free entitlement.

Please note that this concession is only available to vessels in private use. No allowance can be made for any non-use during your concessionary registration period.
