## **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000. MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: TOTAL NUMBER OF ARRESTS**

I refer to your e-mail of 29 January 2018, which was acknowledged on the 30 January 2018.

We are treating your e-mail as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your e-mail you requested the following information:

**“Please could I have the total number of arrests per year over the last 3 years (2015 through to 2017). If this could be broken down into which MDP division/area the arrest occurred this would be helpful but again, if this takes the enquiry above the cost threshold then just the total number of arrests by MDP officers for each year requested will suffice.”**

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request.

2015 – Arrests made by CID - 28 by Uniform officers - 32

2016 – Arrests made by CID - 28 by Uniform officers - 33

2017 – Arrests made by CID - 10 by Uniform officers - 20

Total – 151 arrests

We are unable to provide a breakdown by offence and area.
