

## Introduction

This customer notice is to inform customers of the new TC01R reusable container which is now available to purchase through eLogistics. Please see Customer Notice LLWR-CN-2017-09 Waste Management Services (Packaging) – Reactive Package Supply for details and lead times (see link below),

## TC01R Package Design

This new TC01R Package Design is a fully re-usable variant and has no restrictions on re-use cycles or mileage. A Certificate of Approval for the new TC01R IP-2 HHISO container has been issued and Guidance Note PAA/GN023 has been prepared to provide instructions on how to convert the TC01R to a TC01 Disposal.

## TC01R Maintenance and Inspection.

The TC01R package design containers **MUST** undergo a planned 12 monthly maintenance cycle. Records must be retained and provided to LLWR Packaging Services upon the TC01R reaching the end of its life cycle, in accordance with Operating and Maintenance Instruction OM-3409278\_MECH\_00008. Maintenance activities are to be performed under a Maintenance Quality Plan (MPQ) for containers operated in accordance with the ACEP Maintenance Regime (Ref Section 1.3) and Section 12 of Package Handling Instructions OM-3409278\_MECH\_00008.

**NOTE:** All maintenance activities must be carried out by SQEP'd personnel and spares can be procured through the eLogistics system.

## Final Disposal of the TC01R

The TC01R container is fitted with a HEPA filter assembly, however, prior to transport for final disposal it **MUST** be reconfigured as a TC01 disposal container. The reconfiguration involves removing the HEPA filter and replacing the HEPA Filter assembly with a vent port blanking plate and covering of the "R" on the TC01R identification mark decal located on side B of the container.

To obtain a complimentary configuration kit the custodian can select 'Associated Equipment' in eLogistics under 'TC01R Conversion Kit'. The kit contains all the necessary components and Certificate of Conformity to convert the container to a disposal unit. Guidance Note PAA/GN023 is available on the LLWR website and provides the steps to follow to carry out the conversion (see link below).
