Introductory guidance on managing the non-radiological properties of waste

This guidance, written for waste producers in the nuclear industry, is designed to raise awareness on how to manage the non-radiological properties of waste consignments being diverted from Low Level Waste disposal; it does this by examining how non-radioactive (conventional) waste is managed. Where appropriate, the same principles can be applied to the non-radiological properties of radioactive waste.

Section 4 of the guidance introduces the 7-step process used to classify and code non-radioactive waste in accordance with the Waste Framework Directive.
