## Final New Burdens payment 2017-18 for the Real Time Information Bulk Data Matching initiative

### Introduction

1. This circular is to inform you of the funding that will be allocated to local authorities (LAs) in support of the final cost of New Burdens for the Real Time Information Bulk Data Matching (RTI BDM) initiative 2017-18.
2. Three interim payments have been made to LAs this year and this final payment is based on the actual number of RTI BDM referrals each LA received over the course of the 2017-2018 year.

### Funding details

3. Payment per file will be £10.48 with the payment for debt recovery action remaining unchanged at £5.00. The total payable per case will be £15.48.
4. A breakdown of the funding is given below.

Area of activity	Funding distribution based on	Funding (to the nearest million)
RTI BDM referrals (already paid in 2017-2018)	Distribution was based on the predicted level of files received for each LA area.	<b>£4.0 million</b>
Final payment of RTI BDM referrals for 2017-2018	Distribution is based on the actual files received for 17/18 minus the payments detailed above.	<b>£1.6 million</b>
