

Introduction

The purpose of this customer notice is to inform customers that they may not be able to transport Radioactive Material (RAM) containing asbestos as a Class 7 package after 31st January 2017.

Class 7 Authorisation Expiry

The current authorisation from the Department for Transport (DfT) permitting Radioactive Material (RAM) containing asbestos to be transported as a Class 7 package is due to expire at the end of January 2017.

The Radioactive Material Transport User Committee (RAMTUC) is currently in discussion with the DfT to reach an agreement going forward. If an agreement cannot be reached by the end of January 2017, RAM consignments containing asbestos already packed in Class 7 rated packages may not be transportable.

RAM contaminated with asbestos can continue to be consigned up until the end of January 2017, LLWR advise that adequate alternative arrangements are put in place for consignments containing RAM contaminated asbestos scheduled to be consigned from February 2017 onwards to ensure waste is consigned compliantly in accordance with Transport regulations in a Class 9 package.
