### West Sussex County Council (Warnham) Public Path (No. 1577) Diversion Order, 2013 & West Sussex County Council (Warnham) Public Path (No. 1578) Diversion Order, 2013

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

### The start date for the above Order is 04 April 2018.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert (1) part of footpath 1577 in the parish of Warnham at Warnham Park commencing at its junction with bridleway 3647 (grid 51669 13302) extending north westwards for approximately 743 metres to its junction with footpath 1578 (grid reference 51613 13350) and (2) part of footpath1578 in the Parish of Warnham commencing at its junction with the A24 road (grid reference 51648 13358) extending west south westwards for approximately 200 metres to grid reference 51625 13354, on to a new route from bridleway 3647 (GR 51673 13331) generally north westwards to Bell Road (GR 51609 13372), also with a connection to the A24 road (GR 51658 13346).

## Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 18 April 2018]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

## Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 30 May 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

### Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 10 July 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order(s) must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties <u>everyone should keep to the timetable</u> to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

### PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER Highways Act, 1980

## West Sussex County Council (Warnham) Public Path (No. 1577) Diversion Order, 2013

This order is made by West Sussex County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 below, it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Mr J C Lucas has agreed to contribute towards any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public and to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order.

The Horsham District Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

#### BY THIS ORDER

1. The public right of way over land situate at Warnham and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.

2.Notwithstanding anything in paragraph 1 of this Order, where immediately before the date on which a highway is stopped up in pursuance of this Order there is apparatus on, under or over that highway belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus they then had.

3. There shall be at the end of 21 days from the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situate at Warnham described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.

## Description of site of existing path or way

Part of public footpath no. 1577 in the parish of Warnham at Warnham Park commencing at its junction with bridleway 3647 (grid reference 51669 13302) extending north westwards for approximately 743 metres to its junction with footpath 1578 (grid reference 51613 13350) as shown by the bold black line between the points marked R-S on the attached plan No. 01610/1

## Description of site of new path or way

A new length of public footpath commencing (1) at a point on bridleway 3647 approximately 320 metres north of its original junction (grid reference 51673 13331) with a width of 3 metres entering an arable field and extending generally

north westwards for approximately 234 metres following a field boundary and passing to the west of a 20-30 metre wide buffer zone of new trees to be planted between the A24 road and the new path to grid reference 51654 13345 then turning generally southwestwards along a ditch line for approximately 170 metres and northwestwards for approximately 174 metres to join footpath 1578 at grid reference 51625 13354 as shown by the broken black line between the points marked T-W and W-X on the attached plan 01610/1 and (2) commencing on the A24 Road at grid reference 51658 13346 westwards having a width of 2 metres for approximately 40 metres to grid reference 51656 13345 as shown between the points marked V-W on the attached plan 01610/1

#### PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER Highways Act, 1980

### West Sussex County Council (Warnham) Public Path (No, 1578) Diversion Order, 2013

This order is made by West Sussex County Council ("the Authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 below, it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Mr J C Lucas has agreed to contribute towards any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public and to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order.

The Horsham District Council has been consulted as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

#### BY THIS ORDER

1. The public right of way over land situate at Warnham and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.

2.Notwithstanding anything in paragraph 1 of this Order, where immediately before the date on which a highway is stopped up in pursuance of this Order there is apparatus on, under or over that highway belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus they then had.

3. There shall be at the end of 21 days from the date of confirmation of this Order a public footpath over the land situate at Warnham described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.
