

NOTICE OF ORDER HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 119

Cambridgeshire County Council
Public Footpath No 2, Alconbury Weston (part) Public Path Diversion Order 2015

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is 29 March 2018

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to divert part of Public Footpath No 2, Alconbury Weston, starting at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) TL 1759 7723 and proceeding in an approximately north-north-easterly direction for 434 metres to OSGR TL 1772 7764 then proceeding in an approximately north-north-westerly direction for 14 metres to OSGR TL 1772 7765 to a new line starting at OSGR TL 1759 7723 and proceeding in an approximately north-easterly direction for 175 metres to OSGR TL 1768 7737 then proceeding in an approximately east-north-easterly direction for 20 metres to OSGR TL 1770 7737 then proceeding in an approximately north-easterly direction for 26 metres to OSGR TL 1772 7739. The new line of the path will then run from OSGR TL 1765 7744 and proceed in an approximately north-westerly direction for 32 metres to OSGR TL 1762 7746 then proceed in an approximately north-north-easterly direction for 214 metres to OSGR TL 1772 7765 as shown on the Order Map.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 12 April 2018]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 24 May 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 5 July 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

**PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 - SECTION 119**

**The Cambridgeshire County Council (Public Footpath No 2, Alconbury
Weston (part) Public Path Diversion Order 2015)**

This Order is made by Cambridgeshire County Council ("the authority") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the occupier of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

Mr Philip Baker has agreed to defray any expenses which are incurred in bringing the site of the new path into a fit condition for use by the public.

Huntingdonshire Cambridgeshire District Council have been consulted and Huntingdonshire District Council have consented to the making of the Order as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

BY THIS ORDER:-

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Alconbury Weston and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.
2. There shall at the end of 27 days from the date of confirmation of this Order be a public footpath over the land situate at Alconbury Weston described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the map contained in this Order.
3. The stopping up of the footpath described in Part 1 of the Schedule shall not come into force until Cambridgeshire County Council have certified that the works required to bring the new site of the footpath into a fit condition for use by the public are satisfactory.

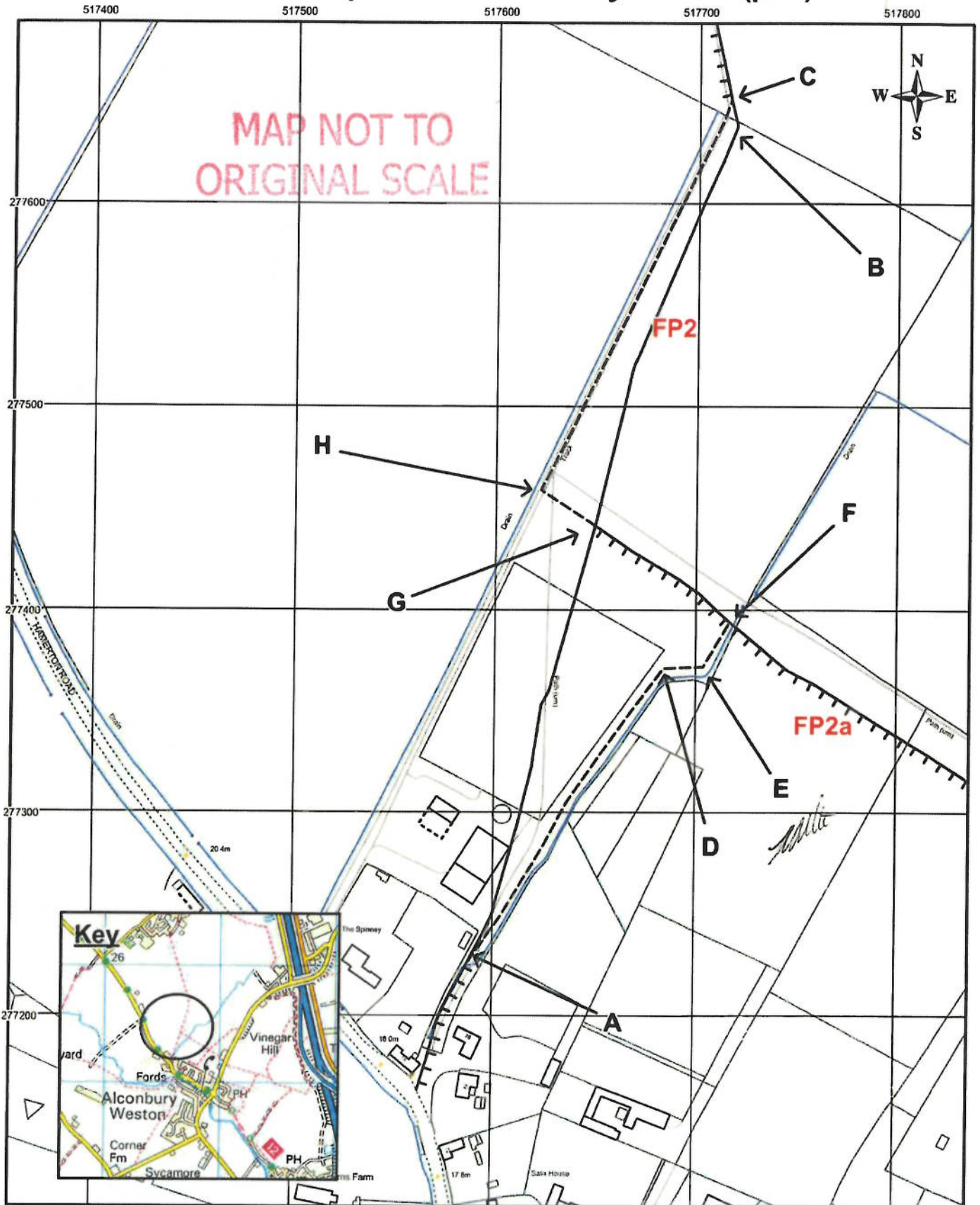
