

Preliminary flood risk assessment: Shropshire Council

This addendum by Shropshire Council (2017) updates the council's preliminary flood risk assessment report published in 2011. Read the addendum in conjunction with the [preliminary assessment report](#).

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for Shropshire Council were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

There have been no changes to Shropshire Council's assessment of flood risk following the review of the PFRA.

Past flood risk

Since 2011, Shropshire Council have had very few significant flood events, none of which have altered or affected the councils understanding of flood risk within the county.

Future flood risk

Shropshire Council has received and created new information about flood risk since the original PFRA publication in 2011. The Sustainable Drainage Systems (SuDS) handbook is currently being finalised with Arcadis and will incorporate the Environment Agency guidance on Climate Change for Planners.

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

No FRAs were identified in Shropshire as part of the publication of the PFRA for the first planning cycle in 2011.

Shropshire Council have not identified any new FRAs for the purposes for the Flood Risk Regulations second planning cycle.
