 - (a) the licensee is a DCC User, the condition applies to the licensee from the date the condition takes effect;
 - (b) the licensee is not a DCC User, the condition applies to the licensee from the date the licensee becomes a DCC User.

PART A: SMETS1 SMART METERING SYSTEMS

Enrolment Duty - SMETS1 Smart Metering Systems Eligible for Enrolment

- 54.2 Paragraph 54.3 applies in respect of each Domestic Premises and Designated Premises at which:
 - (a) the licensee is the Relevant Electricity Supplier;
 - (b) there is a SMETS1 Smart Metering System that is not Enrolled; and
 - (c) the SMETS1 Smart Metering System is Eligible for Enrolment,

(the SMETS1 premises).

- 54.3 Where this paragraph applies the licensee must take all reasonable steps to ensure that within 6 months of:
 - (a) the Eligibility Date; or
 - (b) the date the licensee became the Relevant Electricity Supplier for the SMETS1 premises,

whichever is the later, either:

(c) the Electricity Meter and Communications Hub Function that form part of the SMETS1 Smart Metering System at the SMETS1 premises are Commissioned and the SMETS1 Smart Metering System Enrolled; or (d) a SMETS2+ Smart Metering System is installed at the SMETS1 premises.

Duty relating to SMETS1 Smart Metering Systems that are not Enrolled

- 54.4 Paragraph 54.5 applies in respect of each Domestic Premises and Designated Premises at which:
 - (a) the licensee is the Relevant Electricity Supplier; and

(b) there is a SMETS1 Smart Metering System that is not Enrolled,

(the non-enrolled SMETS1 premises).

54.5 Where this paragraph applies the licensee must ensure that a SMETS2+ Smart Metering System is installed on or before 31 December 2020 at the non-enrolled SMETS1 premises.

PART B: SMETS2+ SMART METERING SYSTEMS

Enrolment Duty – SMETS2+ Smart Metering Systems

54.354.6 Paragraph 54.74 applies in respect of <u>each any</u> Domestic Premises and Designated Premises at which:

- (a) the licensee is the Relevant Electricity Supplier; and
- (b) there is a <u>SMETS2+</u> Smart Metering System-that includes a Communications Hub,

(the relevant premises SMETS2+ premises).

- 54.4<u>54.7</u> Where this paragraph applies: the licensee must take all reasonable steps to ensure that the Electricity Meter and Communications Hub Function that forms part of the <u>SMETS2+</u> Smart Metering System at the <u>relevant-SMETS2+</u> premises <u>are is</u>-Commissioned and the <u>SMETS2+</u> Smart Metering System Enrolled.; and
 - (a) <u>following the time at which such Electricity Meter is first Commissioned and while</u> there is a supply of electricity to the premises, the licensee shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that the Smart Metering System of which the Electricity Meter (or any replacement Electricity Meter) forms part is Enrolled.

(c) the Gas Meter, Communications Hub Function and Gas Proxy Function that form part of the SMETS1 Smart Metering System at the SMETS1 premises are Commissioned and the SMETS1 Smart Metering System Enrolled; or (d) a SMETS2+ Smart Metering System is installed at the SMETS1 premises.

Duty relating to SMETS1 Smart Metering Systems that are not Enrolled

- <u>48.4</u> Paragraph 48.5 applies in respect of each Domestic Premises and Designated Premises at which:
 - (a) the licensee is the Relevant Gas Supplier; and
 - (b) there is a SMETS1 Smart Metering System that is not Enrolled,

(the non-enrolled SMETS1 premises).

48.5 Where this paragraph applies the licensee must ensure that a SMETS2+ Smart Metering System is installed on or before 31 December 2020 at the non-enrolled SMETS1 premises.

PART B: SMETS2+ SMART METERING SYSTEMS

Enrolment Duty - SMETS2+ Smart Metering Systems

- 48.348.6 Paragraph 48.74 applies in respect of <u>each any</u> Domestic Premises and Designated
 Premises at which:
 - (a) the licensee is the Relevant Gas Supplier; and
 - (b) there is a <u>SMETS2+</u> Smart Metering System that includes a Communications Hub,
 - (the relevant premises SMETS2+ premises).
- 48.448.7 Where this paragraph applies: the licensee must take all reasonable steps to ensure that the Gas Meter, the Communications Hub Function and the Gas Proxy Function that form part of the <u>SMETS2+</u> Smart Metering System at the <u>relevant-SMETS2+</u> premises are Commissioned and the SMETS2+ Smart Metering System Enrolled.; and
 - (a) following the time at which such Gas Meter and the Gas Proxy Function are first Commissioned and while there is a supply of gas to the premises, the licensee shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that the Smart Metering System of which the Gas Meter and Gas Proxy Function (or any replacement Gas Meter or Gas Proxy Function) form part are Enrolled.
