It is a condition of registration as a buyer or seller that you keep records of each fish-sale transaction involving first-sale fish for 2 calendar years. These records must also be shown to a marine officer on request. All individuals, partnerships, companies or corporate bodies must provide details of all addresses where these records will be kept.

If you cannot provide an address in the UK, you will be required to submit the records to the relevant fisheries administration once a year and within 28 days of a request from a marine enforcement officer.
