Revocation of an Avian Influenza Prevention Zone

The Secretary of State has carried out a further risk assessment under article 6(1) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (England) (No 2) Order 2006¹ (“the Order”) and declares that the Avian Influenza Prevention Zone that was made on 17 January and has applied since 09.30 on 18 January 2018 is hereby formally revoked in accordance with article 4(1)(e) of the Order at 12.00 on 25 May 2018. The Avian Influenza Prevention Zone no longer applies in any part of England.
