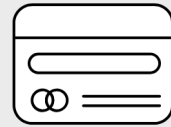

## Step 1

visit

## Send your documents

to the UK Legalisation  
Office. They will process and  
forward documents to the  
Royal Thai Embassy in  
London for you

## Step 2

to complete  
application form, and  
arrange payment



## Step 3

to use your document  
in Thailand  
it must be  
stamped by the  
Ministry of  
Foreign Affairs

**there is no  
requirement**  
for the British Embassy  
in Bangkok  
to stamp your  
documents

always check  
what's required  
with the  
**relevant Thai  
authorities**
