Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The start date for the above Order is 8 June 2018.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding thereto in the Borough of Stamford, a public footpath running from the southern end of the public highway, Cherryholt Road, OS Grid Reference TF 03628 07075, generally south-south-eastwards between two boundary fences for a distance of approximately 40 metres to meet the bank of the River Welland, then running generally north-eastwards along the river bank for a distance of approximately 500 metres to a point on the north side of the river, OS Grid Reference TF 04001 07310, then turning generally north-north-westwards for a distance of approximately 130 metres along a track to the public highway, Priory Road, to the east of the remains of St Leonard's Priory, meeting the highway at a point OS Grid Reference TF 03945 07418. The total length of the path being approximately 670 metres. The width of the path varying between approximately 1 metre and 2 metres.

#### Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

#### Within 2 weeks of the start date (by 22 June 2018)

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or

representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

#### Within 8 weeks of the start date (by 3 August 2018)

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

#### Within 14 weeks of the start date (by 14 September 2018)

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties <u>everyone should keep to the timetable</u> to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.


