

Declaration of Exempt Works

Description of works

Surrey Wildlife Trust (in agreement with the Ministry of Defence) is erecting temporary electric fencing to contain cattle for conservation grazing to increase the biodiversity interest of Royal and Bagmoor Common, for no longer than a period of six months.

The temporary electric fencing will not obstruct any Public Rights of Way.

Royal Common totals 69.74 hectares and Bagmoor Common totals 13.57 hectares the temporary fencing will enclose an area less than 10 hectares. The fencing will be erected on the 18th June 2018.

This grazing compartment incorporates an area of Royal Common and Bagmoor Common.

Located in the:

- (a) Parish/Town of Peperharow and Witley Parishes
- (b) Borough/District/City of Waverley
- (c) County of Surrey

We declare that the works described above are exempt from the requirement for consent under section 38 of the Commons Act 2006 by virtue of the provisions of the Works on Common Land (Exemptions) (England) Order 2007 (SI 2587/2007) and that these works comply with:
