## Freedom of Information Request Re-designation of A12 as A47

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed our search for the information, which you requested on 28 June and in which you asked for:

a) the total cost of the renaming exercise

The total cost of the re-designation of the A12 between Great Yarmouth and Lowestoft was £746,345.50

b) a high level breakdown of the costs

 Scheme design
 £ 64,764.11

 Supervision
 £ 41,071.39

 Work costs
 £637,510.00

c) the cost of manufacturing and installing all the signs that were installed, modified and/or replaced in order to put this change into effect. This should include the signs which state "A47 previously A12".

£ 637,510.00. This figure also includes traffic management and labour costs required as part of the installation process.

The re-designation of the A12 as the A47 was included in the December 2014 "Road Investment Strategy (RIS): Investment Plan" as part of the improvements to the A47/A12 corridor. The scheme was heavily promoted by local Members of Parliament, Norfolk and Suffolk County Councils, the A47 Alliance and local chambers of commerce.



As the A12 south of Lowestoft to the A14 does not form part of the strategic road network, the view was that by re-designating the A12 between Great Yarmouth and Lowestoft as the A47, it would give the route greater prominence and stimulate much needed growth in Great Yarmouth and Lowestoft and better reflect the A47's nature as a continuous corridor.

This was accepted and a commitment by Government was included in the RIS in support of its growth agenda.
